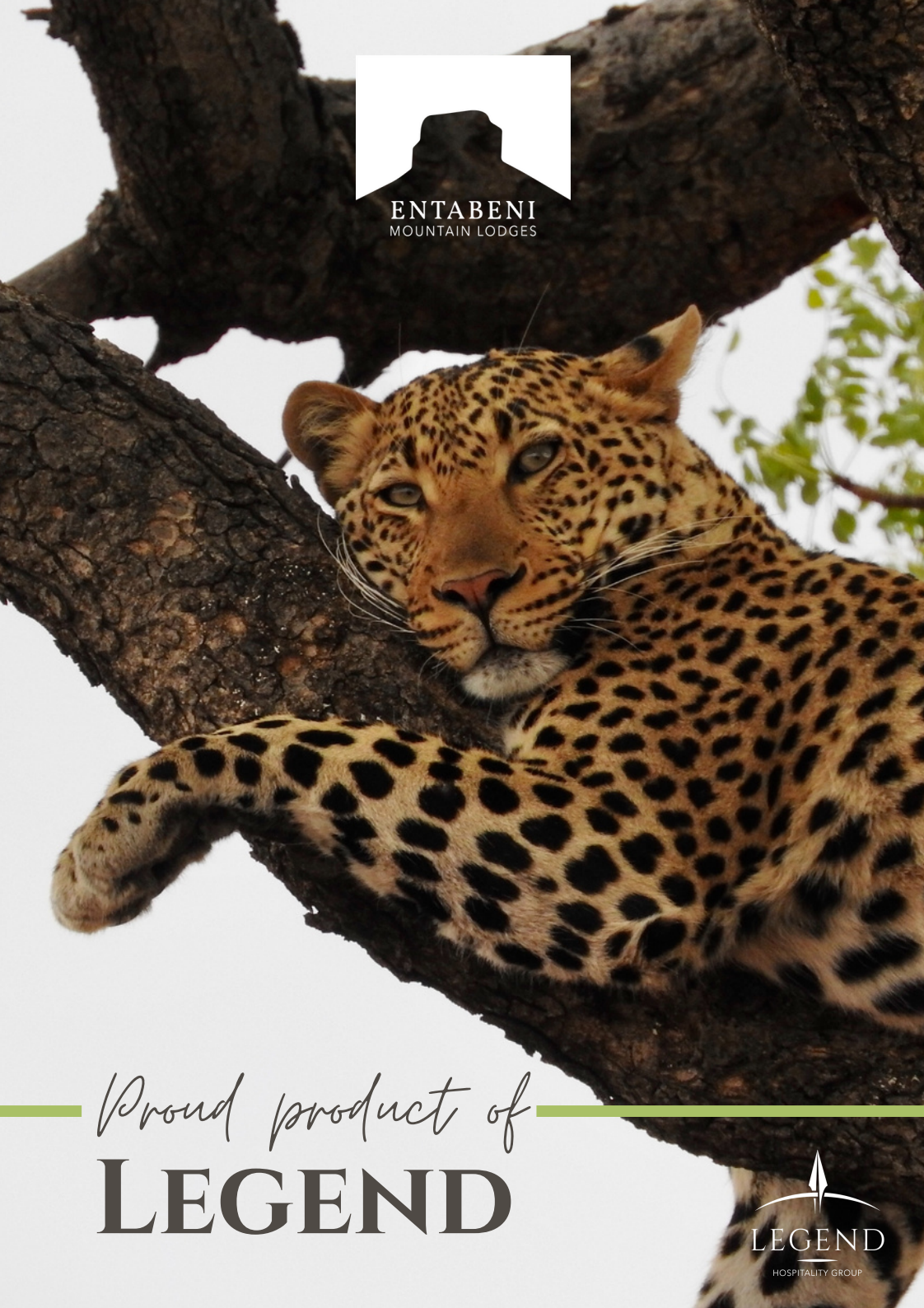

ENTABENI MOUNTAIN LODGES

Entabeni Safari Conservancy, rightfully dubbed "The Place of the Mountain", is situated in the World Heritage Waterberg Biosphere. This 22 000 hectare malaria-free reserve boasts five eco-systems.

A gravel road leads up to the Big 5 reserve, complemented by two of our bespoke lodges, Entabeni Kingfisher Lodge and Entabeni Lakeside Lodge. Each lodge comprises a unique blend of luxury and African wilderness, perfectly set in different immaculate locations of the reserve.



ENTABENI KINGFISHER LODGE

OVERVIEW

Set on the banks of Lake Entabeni, Kingfisher Lodge is the most exclusive and luxurious of all the lodges that Entabeni Safari Conservancy has to offer, offering superb personalised service. In the main lounge and dining area the ambience is inviting with elegant decor, specially designed furniture and a fireplace ensuring an enjoyable and relaxed atmosphere.





ACCOMMODATION

The lodge has a spacious lounge/dining room, which opens onto a wooden deck. The 12 Deluxe bedrooms are stylishly decorated and feature fireplaces, mini-bars and private decks.

The lodge is also equipped to accommodate guests with mobility challenges.

The honeymoon suite features an exquisite four poster bed and a jacuzzi bath with views of the lake.

BREAKDOWN OF ROOMS

Entabeni Kingfisher Lodge has a total of 12 Deluxe bedrooms with 4 of the rooms having mosquito nets, big bath-tubs and views of Lake Entabeni.

ENTABENI LAKESIDE LODGE

OVERVIEW

Set on the banks of the 1.7km lake, this thatched lodge provides a memorable blend of luxury and wilderness with the awe-inspiring Entabeni Mountain as a backdrop.

The hippos at Lake Entabeni are a site to behold and the viewing deck provides the perfect setting for spectacular views over the lake.





ACCOMMODATION

The bedrooms are linked by walkways to the reception, restaurant, conference room and boma. Spacious double/twin rooms are complemented by sundowners on your own private deck with the ever-changing colours of the Entabeni Mountain reflecting in the lake.

BREAKDOWN OF ROOMS

Entabeni Lakeside Lodge has a total of 20 elegantly furnished bedrooms with one room being a Wheelchair room.

DIRECTIONS

Road Directions to Entabeni Mountain Lodges:

Take the N1 North Highway from Pretoria to Polokwane (Pietersburg). Keep on the N1 through the Carousel and Kranskop Tollgates. Travel a further 32 km on the N1. Take the Mookgopong (Naboomspruit) R101A off ramp/exit (Route 289). Drive 8 km to Mookgopong.

Turn left at the second traffic light in town centre (R520) into Nelson Mandela Road. Continue on the R520 for 11 km until you reach a T-junction (in front of you will be The Olifantjie Padstal).

Turn left and continue for 300m and turn right at the Marken sign, continue on the tar road for 24 km. The road becomes a gravel road. Continue on this road for another 21.5 km. You'll see an ENTABENI sign on the right-hand side. Turn right and drive 3.3 km on a dirt road until you reach the security entrance gate.



TAKE NOTE

It is recommended that guests follow these directions instead of relying on a GPS as game fencing restricts access to certain roads in rural areas.
